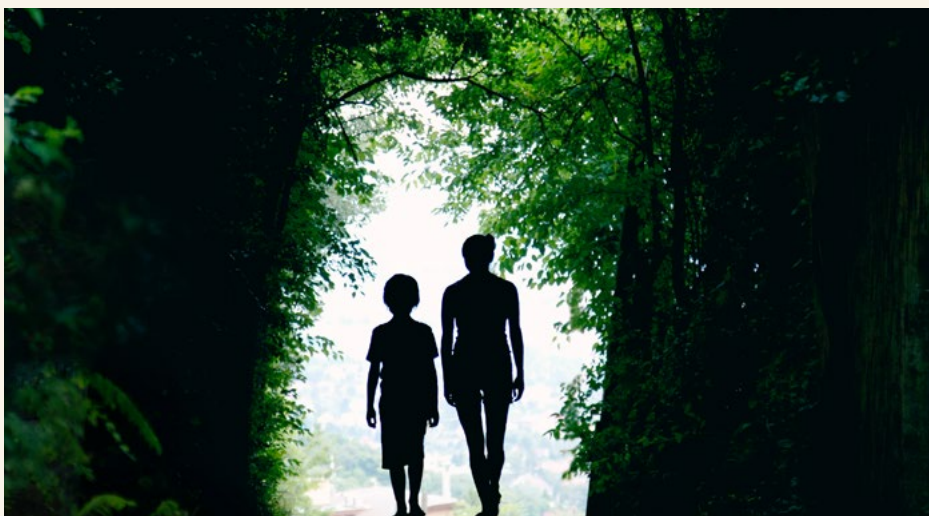

SYNOPSIS
